A local law repealing Chapter 98 and amending Chapters 139 and 241 of the City Code of the City

Chapter 98 of the City Code of the City of Plattsburgh (hereafter "City Code"), entitled "Recreation Department" is repealed in its entirety.

Chapter 139, §139-1, and §139-1 (A) and (D) are amended to read as follows:

§139-1. Issuance of permits.

The City Clerk is authorized to issue permits for admission to the City Beach to residents of the City of Plattsburgh and the Town of Plattsburgh.

- A. Before issuing any such permit, there shall be exhibited to the City Clerk a certificate of registration, currently in effect, of the applicant' automobile, family van not exceeding a ten-passenger capacity, pickup truck not exceeding a one-ton capacity, motorcycle or motorbike and indicating that he is a resident of Clinton County. No permits will be issued for busses, trucks or other commercial vehicles.
- D. All permits shall be nontransferable, and the City Clerk shall keep a record of all permits issued.

Chapter 241 §241-6(3) is amended so to read:

3. Permits. The City Clerk is authorized to issue a permit that grants a person the license and privilege to use a City Park during the hours when such a park is closed on such conditions as the City Clerk deems necessary to prevent excessive noise or vandalism.

This Local Law shall take effect upon approval by the Mayor and filing with the New York Secretary of State.


